ORDINANCE NUMBER 444

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MEYERSDALE, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING AND ABANDONING A PORTION OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF A PUBLIC ROAD KNOWN AS ALASKA STREET, SOUTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF ALASKA STREET AND 6TH AVENUE, SOUTH TO THE INTERSECTION OF ALASKA STREET TO 8TH AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF MEYERSDALE, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Meyersdale, Somerset County, Pennsylvania as follows:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Meyersdale has laid out Alaska Street as a 66 foot wide right-of-way in the DiPasquale Plan of Lots.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Meyersdale desires to vacate this portion of Alaska Street from the intersection of 6th Avenue and Alaska St., South to the intersection of 8th Avenue and Alaska Street.

WHEREAS, this portion of Alaska Street was never opened.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Meyersdale has received a request from the Meyersdale Municipal Authority and the Meyersdale Little League to donate a portion of Alaska Street to the Meyersdale Little League.

WHEREAS, the Meyersdale Little League field has occupied the portion of Alaska Street from the intersection of Alaska Street and 6th Ave., South to the intersection of Alaska Street and 8th Avenue.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Meyersdale has the authority to vacate by Ordinance the portion of Alaska Street under 8 PS section 1731.

WHEREAS, the portion of Alaska Street to be closed is not currently accessible by any neighboring property nor is it the only means for ingress and egress for any abutting landowner.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Meyersdale has advertised this Ordinance in the newspaper and all adjoining landowners were given personal service of the ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Meyersdale Ordains and Enacts the following:

The portion of Alaska Street from the intersection of 6th Avenue and Alaska St., South to the intersection of 8th Avenue and Alaska Street is hereby VACATED.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED into an Ordinance this 13th day of February, 2024.


